Read the full passage in your Bible - Deuteronomy 15:1-11.



Why would God make a law about canceling debts? Is it about the money or is there a heart issue He's after?

How does a material thing, like forgiving debt, have a spiritual effect?

Is there a debt (monetary or otherwise) someone owes you that you could forgive today? How would you explain to them why you've forgiven it?
